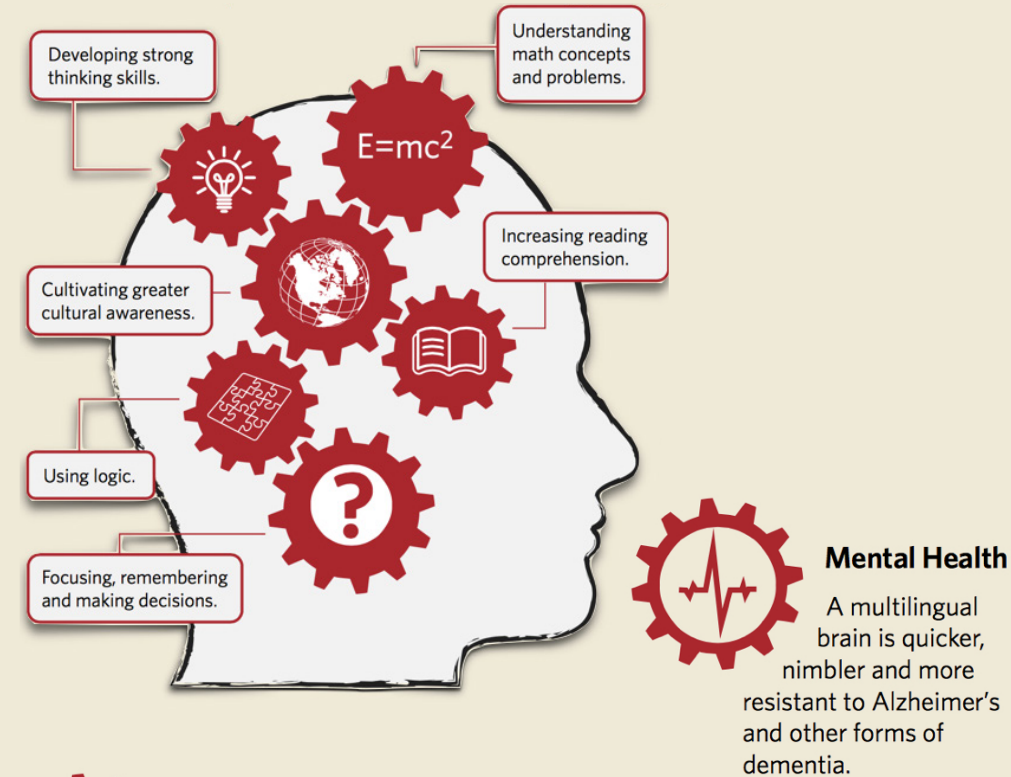


Benefits of a Bilingual Brain

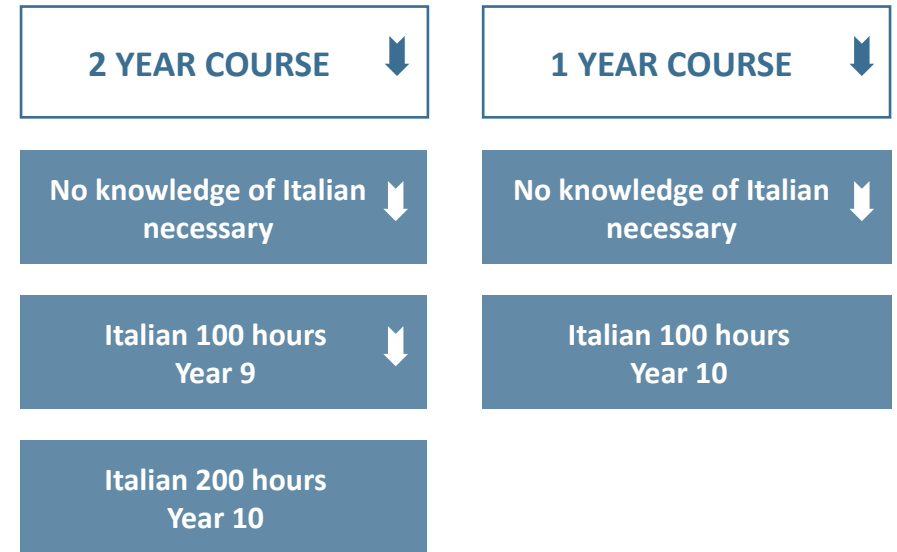
WHY LEARN ITALIAN?
