





Students are permitted to wear sports shoes during sport but must change when returning to school.






Every student is required to wear the correct socks and accessories

Patterned, colourful or non-school coloured scarves are not permitted


Please keep jewellery to a minimum for safety reasons


Chokers are not permitted at school. Longer necklaces can be tucked into shirts.

Facial peircings other than a simple nose ring are not permitted at school. Septums can be tucked away.

Ear peircings other than standard lobes are to be clear or plain rings.





Students who do not comply with the uniform expectations:

- > are expected to provide a note of explanation from a parent/carer
- warnings are issued
- > detentions can be given
- > text messages are sent to parents (for repeated offences)
- > follow up phone call and a letter sent home (for repeated offences)
- > Deputy Principal referral and further disciplinary action can occur

they can access their phone at the end of the school day by using the unlocking stations;


there are consequences for students who have their phones out during the day.






STARTING HIGH SCHOOL - ASSESSMENT

throughout the year in each subject.



Attendance Rewards

Titanium - 100% for the year

Gold – 100% for a term & Gold plus for a semester

Silver – >90% for a semester Bronze – >90% for the term

Fortnightly (Minor prize draw) Students with >90% attendance over a two-week period, will be entered into a fortnightly draw for a canteen voucher to the value of \$10 - drawn at assembly.

One voucher per year group (students must be present to collect or a redraw will be conducted). SASS to search and print the list of students >90%. DP to conduct draw.

Year Meetings

Weeks 4 & 8 - students who have significantly improved their attendance are recognised with a certificate for improving their attendance-presented by the year advisor. YA to identify and present.

School Cup

Gold level attendance recognised at School Cup - all students presented with a certificate and a randomised draw conducted for a \$100 family community voucher.

Silver & Bronze attendance certificate emailed to parents.

\$75 Community Voucher

Week 10 (Major prize draw) Deputy Principal conducts a draw on a random day in week 10 for all students who have qualified. SASS to collate a list of eligible students and place outside DP windows by recess Monday week 10.

To qualify, students will have been eligible for at least one fortnightly minor prize draw throughout the term. If a student qualifies for more than one minor prize draw, they will have multiple tickets for the major prize.

Semester 1 & 2

Rewards activity for all students who have >90% attendance for the Semester.

End of Year Awards 100% attendance for the year recognised with the student receiving a \$200 school credit.

Note: All winners of prizes are to be published in the newsletter or communicated through CHHS Facebook.

All gold, gold plus & titanium levels of attendance are published in the CHHS newsletter.

TARGETED SPORTS PROGRAM **INFORMATION - 2024**

THE PROGRAM

The Targeted Sports Program (TSP) is a selective sports program delivered at CHHS with five sport strands including Basketball, Soccer/Futsal, Rugby League, Girls Footy Sports (Touch, League Tag, Tackle) & Netball for selected students in Years 7-10.

All TSP strands participate in weekly skill development, conditioning gameplay, coaching, teamwork & goal setting they also play organised interschool games on the North Coast and Hunter areas.

There are 7 TSP coordinators that lead each sport. TSP coordinators mentor students and work with them to improve their educational outcomes, performance and achieve personal goals.

The aim is to prepare students for elite pathways and utilise sport as the tool to improve them as young people and achieve CHHS's 3 core values - respect, responsibility and doing your best.

Late Term 4 and early Term 1, students express interest, complete an application package including an attendance commitment standards however with this comes privileges and evaluation, student background such as numerous extracurricular activities and information and complete a rigorous 7-week excursions. Each strand attends a professional trial process. Students are assessed on their experience excursion, for example the League behaviour, attendance, fitness, skill and strands attend an NRL excursion where they abilities, game play, effort and application with final squads selected of up to 20 students.

There is an annual fee - included is TSP training apparel (tee shirt, shorts, track pants, jacket) and assists in subsidising equipment, travel costs and contributes to other minor excursions.

Training

All TSP strands receive expert training from qualified and experienced coaches in their chosen sport including a specific strength and conditioning program for each student to complete during lunchtimes in the school fitness centre with CHHS strength and conditioning coach. Students must wear their TSP uniform for all training sessions, games

Other Opportunities


Students in the TSP must meet academic, attendance, behavioural and performance watch the Newcastle Knights team play, meet players and play games against Newcastle schools.






IMPORTANT NOTICES



YEAR 7 SPORT - THURSDAYS Periods 3&4

Full school sports uniform to be worn

Out of uniform? Students need a note from their parent/carer and bring an alternate shirt

No note no participation detention room.

Term 1 - Gender-based teams participate in round robin competition at school at no cost

Term 2 - Randomly mixed-gender teams participate in round robin competition at school at no cost

Term 3 - Students select a sport held on school grounds at no cost

Term 4 - Students select a sport either at school or in the local community

YEAR 7 SPORT – SPORT SESSION

ROLL MARKING, NOTIFICATIONS

At the beginning of each sport session students meet in the Year 7 area and sit in their teams to have their names marked off.

Teacher messages are given and expectations reiterated.



YEAR 7 SPORT – A TYPICAL SPORT SESSION

The teacher introduces the sport, the specific skills and the rules of the game.

This is followed up by a warmup, which is conducted to increase circulation, raise body temperature and simulate the sporting movements to be played. It also helps to reduce the chance of injury.

Time is spent practising the specific skills of the sport.
