

BULLYING. NO WAY!

STUDENT TIPS

If it happens in person, try these:

- Ignore them try not to show any reaction
- Tell them to stop and walk away
- Pretend you don't care
- Go somewhere safe
- Get support from your friends

If it happens online, try these:

- Avoid responding to the bullying
- Report and block a cyberbully
- Protect yourself online using privacy settings and keep records

If you see someone being bullied:

- Leave negative conversations/gossip.
 Don't join in.
- Support others being bullied

If it doesn't stop:

 Talk to an adult (parent/carer/staff member) who can help stop the bullying.





PARENT TIPS

If your child talks to you about bullying:

- Listen calmly and get the whole story
- Reassure them
- Ask them what they want you to do and how you can help
